## 2019 Hatchet Hoops Spring League Rules

- 1) Teams will consist of 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> grade boys.
- 2) Games will be played in the Fieldhouse.
- 3) Format will be four on four or five on five. The baskets will be set at 9 feet.
- 4) Four eight minute quarters, running clock, clock will stop the last minute of the game. No overtime will be played.
- 5) No player can foul out, no bonus, free throws will be shot on shooting fouls.
- 6) Each team is allowed one time out per half.
- 7) Players will line up at half court to "match up" at the start of each quarter. Man to man defense must be played at all times.
- 8) No full court press at any time.
- 9) No subbing on the fly. Players must check in at the scorer's table.
- 10) Each player will take one lay-up and shoot one free throw to start the game. One point will be scored for each made basket. If a team is short a player they will be allowed to take an extra lay-up and free throw.
